

B.S.S.A. THORN 800
OPEN MEETING CONDITIONS
SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 20 2015

80 SHOTS @ 50 METRES plus optional 50 SHOTS @ 100 YARDS

VENUE: Thorn Ranges, Thorn, Bedfordshire. Range is situated approx. 2 miles north of Dunstable just off the A5. Map can be given upon request.

SQUADDING: All competitors will be squadded. The first squad will commence promptly at 10.00 am (Ranges will be open by 9.15 am. Each detail will be of 30 minutes, 20 minutes for shooting and 10 Minutes for target changing. Details of squadding will be emailed to each competitor. Postal squadding notice can be given if stamped address envelope enclosed with entry form.

RANGE COMMITTEE: All disputes shall be referred to the Range Committee and any 3 of whom shall form a quorum.

TARGETS: N.S.R.A. 1989 series 50 metre targets will be used. They will be issued to competitors on the firing point.

PRIZES Bedford Target Supplies Vouchers (BTS) will be given according to entry and size of class

CLASSIFICATION: *If you entered the July Grand Slam we already have your average so please ignore the following:-*

BSSA will be classifying competitors in a unique classes system **regardless** of National Classification. BSSA X Class is made up of shooters in & previously in X Class within the past 3 years.

Competitors who have not entered any of the BSSA Meetings during the last two years other than those entering Class X or A must ensure that their correct average based on the best last six scores made on 1989 series targets (25 yards) is given on the entry form, (abnormally low scores will be deleted) with the scores from which it is computed. **THIS MUST BE FILLED IN AND SIGNED.** Competitors failing to do so will be placed in **A CLASS**.

CLASS A - 97.0 over

CLASS B - 94.1 to 96.9

CLASS C – up to 94.0

TIES will be decided by count back scores. Taking target 8 and counting back from there.

SIGHTING SHOTS: **Unlimited on Target No. 1 only. On all subsequent targets, all shots to count.**

CHALLENGES These will be charged at £2.00 per card refunded if successful.

Check your scores before leaving the range. No challenges or objections can be entertained after conclusion of the day's competition.
