'Thorn Last Shot' Competition



Despite the best efforts of those involved in trying to keep Thorn open until a new shooting facility is in place, it is disappointing to advise we have been unsuccessful in the quest. A new range location has been identified but it will be 18months minimum, if at all, to get the new location usable.

Thorn Range will close immediately following the March 2017 'English Match' open meeting. Central Bedfordshire Council retake control of the land on the 24th March.

To mark the closure the **'Thorn Last Shot'** Competition will take place after the final detail of the English Match at around 4 pm.

For the 'Last Shot', competitors will fire a SINGLE SHOT, at 100 yds, during a five second period. The winning shot will be that nearest the centre.

The winning shot will receive an engraved commemorative piece of glassware.

Entry fee: £10 minimum donation to the Thorn Range fund.

Non refundable in any circumstances

Special Conditions for the Last Shot:

One squad only, places limited by available firing points, entry on first come basis.

Five minute sighting period, unlimited sighters may be fired.

One minute pause, after sighting period.

On the RO's command, one round to be loaded.

Single shot to be fired during a five second period, indicated by the buzzer sounding.

Cross shots: Perpetrator – A miss (as good as a mile).

Recipient – receives benefit of best shot.

Ties: In the event that the scorers cannot determine a single winning shot; the winner shall be determined by drawing lots.

Challenges: Any challenge is to be accompanied by a £1000 non-refundable fee. Challenges will be considered, and rejected, by a panel of three BSSA committee members.
