### Frostbite League 2021- 22

#### It's good to get back to shooting following the Covid restrictions in 2020 and into 2021.

BSSA once again have decided to run a Frostbite League during the coming winter. The format will be the same as the last few years and open to all abilities and classes but with possible separations in place.

**Venue:** Bedford Range, Clapham Road, Bedford, MK41 6EN. Check Bedford Rifle club web site for access map details. Please note that there is a maximum of 24 places, if more than 24 shooters enter, names will be drawn on a first come first served basis. There is also a minimum of 18 to make sure the competition is viable to run.

A start will be allocated to each competitor based on their average ex 400 in the Beds 50M and 100 yds Leagues or National Long-Range League, if Beds not entered. In the case of persons who have not shot sufficiently at long range to obtain an average, their 25 yds Beds average will be considered. Please state on the entry form where your average has been taken from.

**Competition No. 1:** 20 shots at either 50M or 100 yds (see programme below) with unlimited sighters shooting against your submitted average which will have been converted into your start.

**Competition No. 2:** 30 shots at either 50M or 100 yds (see programme below). All shots to count, no sighters, conditions as above.

**Competition No. 3:** 30 shots at either 50M or 100 yds (see programme below). All shots to count, no sighters, conditions as above.

All cards will be scored on the range and prizes awarded at the end of each day's shooting.

**Competition No. 4:** The whole entry will be divided as near as possible into three equal divisions and aggregated throughout the six rounds to form the Frostbite League. Competitors must shoot five rounds to qualify. The trophies for this competition will be presented at the end of the last shoot on Sunday February 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

**Times:** Assemble at 9.00 am to set up range. **(All to help).** Commence Shooting at 10.15 am.

#### Frostbite dates and course of fire:

Sunday November 7 <sup>th</sup> 2021	80 shots @ 50 Metres
Sunday November 28 <sup>th</sup> 2021	80 shots @ 100 yds
Sunday December 12 <sup>th</sup> 2021	80 shots @ 50 Metres plus Xmas shoot.

*Note: If you wish to take part in the Xmas shoot prize draw, please ensure that your prize costs no less than £5.00 and bring it on the day.*

Sunday January 9 <sup>th</sup> 2022	80 shots @ 100 yds
Sunday January 23 <sup>rd</sup> 2022	80 shots @ 50 Metres
Sunday February 13 <sup>th</sup> 2022	80 shots @ 100 yds

**Refreshments:** Tea, Coffee and Biscuits will be provided free of charge but donations will be gratefully accepted.

**Entry fee:** £35.00 per competitor (£29 per junior) for all 6 shoots.
